RE: Whole School Approach to Well-being in Enfield

Enfield Grammar School is taking part in the Sandwell Well-being Charter Mark – a whole school approach to well-being in Enfield. The School will be working with the Enfield Educational Psychology service to find out how the School is supporting its community and where it could be doing more to promote positive well-being. We will be exploring areas of success and development, creating an action plan for the School.

As part of this project, we would like to gain the views of our pupils with regard to their experiences of the School, exploring questions around well-being. To do this, we will be using a variety of tools including a staff survey, student survey, student focus groups and parent focus groups.

Students in years 7, 9, 11 and 13 will be randomly selected to participate in the focus group sessions. Individual parents/carers will be contacted separately regarding this.

Students in years 8, 10 and 12 will be asked to complete an online survey during the week commencing 16 March 2020. The survey will be anonymous and pupils do not have to answer questions and can opt out of completing the survey altogether if they wish.

This information will be collated by Sandwell and fed back to the School. We will ensure that pupil names and/or identifying features are not used. This report may also be used for wider audiences and, if this is the case, the views collected may be included.

We will also be holding two Parent Focus Group meetings on **Tuesday 31 March 2020 at 4.00pm** and **Thursday 2 April 2020 at 8.45am – 9.45am** at the Upper School.
