Dear Parent/Carer

RE: CORONAVIRUS – UPDATE FOR THURSDAY 2 APRIL 2020

I am writing to share with you my thanks and gratitude for your support of the School over the past two weeks and to update you on a few important issues that will affect us all in the coming weeks.

Both my Deputies will be writing to you tomorrow, Friday 3 April 2020, focusing on Family Well-Being and Home-Learning which are two of the areas that they both lead on respectively; Mr Purrier leads on Well-Being and Mrs Burke leads on Learning. These letters will hopefully answer some of the FAQs and will explain how, as a school, we intend to proceed after the two week Easter break. I have received lots of feedback on what has been offered so far and I hope to have an improved provision moving forward. Please read both letters carefully as there will be lots of information to help you and your families over the prolonged period of National Lockdown.

As a School, we are opening over the Easter break for students whose parents are keyworkers and where their attendance at work is critical. It is essentially a childcare service that the School will be offering, but this service will be provided using the minimum number of staff, unlike the provision put in place during term time. The format for these days will be less structured and although there will be some learning, it will be more flexible and informal. Your son will not be required to wear school uniform, but should wear their Enfield Grammar School PE kit, including tracksuit bottoms and hoodies, if needed. These items of clothing should **NOT** be worn in their homes, and will need to be washed daily, ready to wear for the next time they are in school over the Easter period. Students will also need to bring a packed lunch. The day will start at 9am and finish at 3pm and will take place at the Upper Site. Please inform me as soon as possible, should you wish to use this service.

I would also like to inform you that Enfield Grammar School have joined the Foodbank Scheme and I have a number of food vouchers available for families who are struggling at this present time. These vouchers can be collected from the School Office on the Upper School site. Each voucher will provide enough food to feed your family for three days. Please let me know either by email at office@enfieldgrammar.org or by telephone on 020 8363 1095 between 9am and 10am daily, if you would like to collect a voucher and I will ensure that they are made available for you.

May I take this opportunity to wish you a Happy Easter and, once again, thank you all for your continued support during these difficult and challenging times.
