Dear parent carers

I hope that you are well.

It has been fantastic to hear that some of our post-16 students have taken up the offer of the Covid-19 vaccine over the last couple of weeks, as have some parent carers who have been recognised as 'carers' for those Clinically Extremely Vulnerable. We hope that this is recognised more widely for more of our community. I know that so many families, particularly those who are supporting remote learning, are looking forward to some normality, structure and social inclusion.

It was heart-warming to be part of a Futures class wellbeing check-in with their fellow students at home. Students shared their experiences of receiving the vaccine other using verbal language, gestures, and Makaton signing to encourage each other to 'go for it' and 'be brave'. I have received lots of positive feedback about peer support making all the difference to the wellbeing of our children and young people across the school. If you would like to explore this experience with your child/ young person at home, please let your class teacher know so that they can arrange this.

The situation this week - Class bubble closures

- Thankfully there have been zero positive Covid cases impacting on class bubbles this week.
- 1 class bubble closed and re-opened following a negative test result.
- The 3 class bubbles returned on Monday, following negative test results.
- There have been no asymptomatic cases identified from the lateral flow tests of staff or pupils.
- We are happy to report that we close the week with zero bubble closures.

Curriculum update

In the autumn term we introduced a brand new role of Curriculum Leads, to work alongside our Department Leads and Co-ordinators, developing and driving forward our exciting, fun and challenging curricula. We have taken parent carer feedback to ensure all children and young people are never limited by the department they are in or the curriculum that they follow.

Departments are working on building theme-days into the curriculum and developing exciting events for the rest of the year. We will be gathering parent carer input to inform theme days and celebration events. Keep your eyes peeled for the following upcoming events: National Careers week, World Book day, Science week and Red Nose Day.

This is in addition to our usual 90+ schools transport vehicles that enter and exit our Monkmoor site.
