Shevington High School is a very popular 11-16 community school located in the village of Shevington, 3 miles from Wigan town centre and five minutes from the M6 motorway. The school is smaller than the average size secondary school but growing. We currently have our biggest year in Year 7 with 172 students.

In January 2017 the school was judged by Ofsted as Good in all categories and in recognition of our outstanding practice and work we have done to support, other schools we were designated a National Support School


