

CORONAVIRUS RELATED ABSENCE REFERENCE GUIDE FOR PARENTS/CARERS 0207 540 5620

What to do if:	Action needed:	Return to school when:
My son has coronavirus symptoms	 DO NOT send your son to school Inform school immediately Your son must self-isolate Get your son tested 	- The test comes back negative
My son tests positive for coronavirus	 DO NOT send your son to school Inform school immediately Your son must self-isolate for at least 10 days 	Your son can return to school after 10 days even if he has a cough or loss of taste and smell. These symptoms can last for several weeks once the infection has gone
Somebody in my household has coronavirus symptoms	 DO NOT send your son to school Inform school immediately Your son must self-isolate Household member to get a test 	- The household member's test is negative
Somebody in my household has tested positive for coronavirus	 DO NOT send your son to school Inform school immediately Your son must self-isolate for 14 days 	- Your son has completed 14 days of self-isolation
NHS test and trace has identified my son as a 'close contact' of somebody with symptoms or confirmed coronavirus	 DO NOT send your son to school Inform school immediately Your son must self-isolate for 14 days or follow the guidance given in the test and trace message. 	- Your son has completed 14 days of self-isolation
We have travelled or may travel and my son must self-isolate as part of period of quarantine	 DO NOT take unauthorised leave in term time Consider quarantine requirements and FCO advice when booking travel 	 Your son's quarantine period of 14 days has been completed NB: any unauthorised absence is recorded and further action may be taken if appropriate.
