

Remote Teaching of Reading

Woodcroft has implemented ways to improve our teaching of reading during lockdown. To help pupils we introduced two apps that will be used in every class from Nursery to Year 6: these are **Readworks** and **Edpuzzle**.

Teachers will be reading aloud and recording short videos that pupils will watch using Edpuzzle.
