(middle of words): coat, float, moan, road	Teach digraph oo (<i>as in book</i>). Show the grapheme, recap the action and model letter formation. Listen for the oo phoneme in words. Where do you usually find it? (middle of words): took, shook, hood, wool	Teach digraph oo (as in moon). Show the grapheme, recap the action and model letter formation. Listen for the oo phoneme in words. Where do you usually find it? (middle of words): soon, food, zoom, boot	Teach digraph ar. Show the grapheme, recap the action and model letter formation. Listen for the ar phoneme in words. Where do you usually find it? (middle/end of words): car, far, start, farmer	Teach phase 3 tricky words: her, you, my.
