	Monday 8 th March	You've Got a Friend in Me: Will time apart have changed my friendships?	Luke 4:1-13	IU Jesus' 40 days of isolation from his friends/society; link to us being isolated from and missing our friends; discuss how we can pick up where we left off with our friendships.
	Monday 15 th March	Determination: How and why should we never give up?	Mark 10:46-52	JP Jesus heals blind Bartimaeus; link to being determined during this pandemic - we are all "blind" to what the future holds but Possible ideas from: https://www.barnabasinschools.org.uk/idea/determination-not-giving
	Monday 22 nd March	The Easter Story: How was the first Easter both a time of despair and hope?	Luke 24:6-7	AR The Easter story told in a nutshell through the lens of the themes of "despair" and "hope" to set up ready for next week's Easter 2021 focus.
	Monday 29 th March	Easter 2021: How can the Easter story give us hope now in times of despair?	Jeremiah 29:11	HS Draw parallel between Jesus' death/Resurrection and the challenges of Covid-19/the hope of a brighter future; relate back to week 1 of this half term.
