Year 9 Consultation Evening - Tuesday 9 and Wednesday 10 March 4.30 -7.30pm

The Consultation Evening is mainly a chance for you and your daughter to have online appointments with her subject teachers about her progress this year, but it may also be helpful in making option choices.
