As you are aware, the government has announced that schools are allowed to re-open. Hartsdown will be reopening on the **8 March for all students** and we are really looking forward to seeing your children and getting back to our core tasks of looking after your child's welfare and their academic progress.

As part of our preparation for this we have an inset day **Friday 5 March** where there will not be remote learning or key worker provision on this date.

Student Testing

To reduce the risk of bringing Covid into school we will be conducting testing for students prior to their return. Students will be having two tests prior to return and one test in school. After this all testing can take place at home.

Students do not need an appointment time, they can turn up at main school reception on the given day between the times given. Please be aware, your child may have a short wait on their arrival.

Please note that we have scheduled year 8 and 9 testing to coincide with the timings for the HPV vaccine so they can have both while they are at school.

Keeping Children Safe

The changes we made for the Autumn term will continue and I have reiterated these below. In addition the government has mandated that: **Unless exempt, students must wear masks in the school building.** If students forget their mask, they will be able to purchase a disposable mask for 50p.

Children who are exempt should wear a lanyard or similar. Information about exemptions and how to acquire a lanyard are available <u>here</u>. If you have any questions please contact SEN.

In most cases COVID19 presents little risk to children with the majority of children having no symptoms. It is however essential that we reduce the risk as some children and adults are vulnerable to serious complications if they succumb to COVID19. The following are therefore in place:

- Children have specific year areas for lunch and breaks. We have also staggered breaks.
- In KS3, children mainly stay in the same room and staff will come to them.
- Students must bring their own equipment
 - Pen/Pencil/Ruler
 - A scientific calculator
 - A glue stick
 - A protractor
 - A pair of compasses
 - Tissues
 - A good sized bag

Visiting the school

In line with government guidance parents **must** book an appointment prior to coming to the school. We **will not** admit parents without an appointment. Hygiene

We have provided sanitiser at the entrance to the school and in every classroom. Your child must sanitise their hands on arrival at school and in each classroom. Children will also be required to follow good respiratory hygiene when they cough or sneeze following the 'catch it, kill it, bin it' advice.
