The programme is completely flexible, students can work towards an Award or a full Certificate. Either way, students will have the chance to try lots of new things such as:

- Learning all sorts of new skills to help with meeting new people and building their confidence
- Taking on a business challenge to put their entrepreneurial skills to the test
- Improving their knowledge and ability to look after themselves and live a healthy life
- Top tips to help them write the perfect CV and get ahead in their career

Put it on their CV

All of the things they do through the Achieve programme will count towards a recognised **Prince's Trust qualification** that they can put on their CV or UCAS form.

Students work together as a group on practical learning projects which are designed to build their confidence, improve self-esteem and attainment.

The students build a portfolio of work which is externally accredited. There is no exam.



Students are given the attention they need to learn skills and to develop confidence, as well as to form a sense of ownership over their work and own development.
