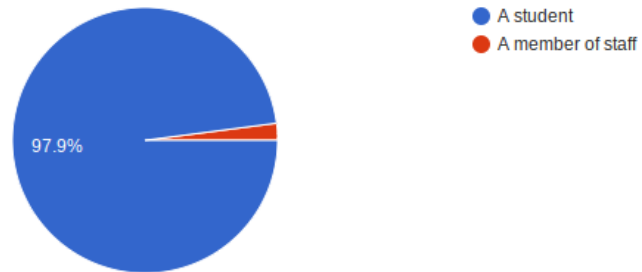

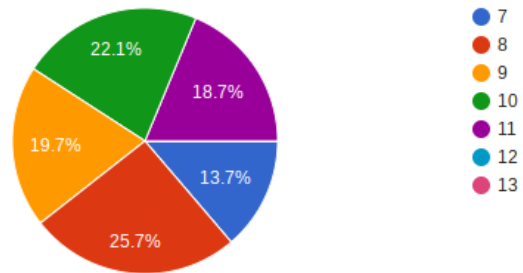

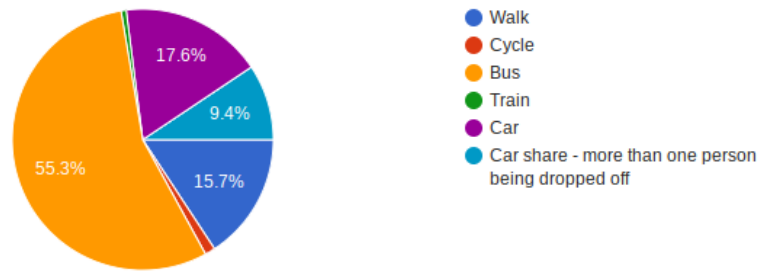

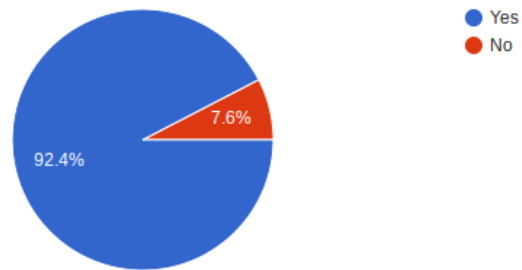
How do you get to school most of the time?

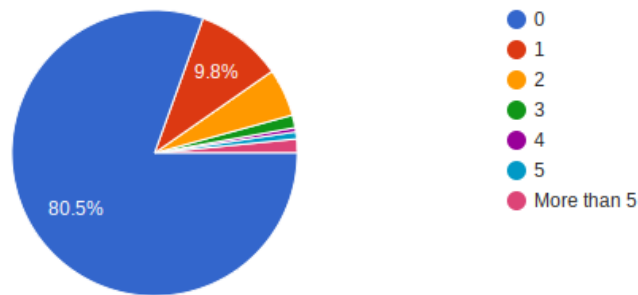
Do you have your own re-usable water bottle that you bring to school?

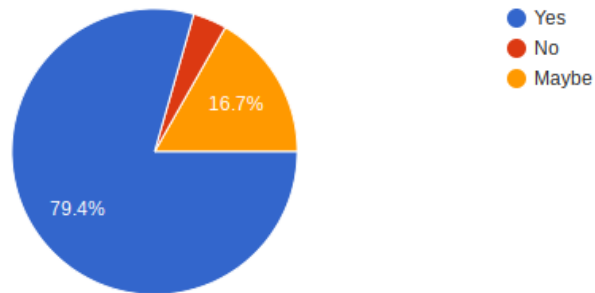
How many times a week do you buy a drink in a single use plastic bottle?

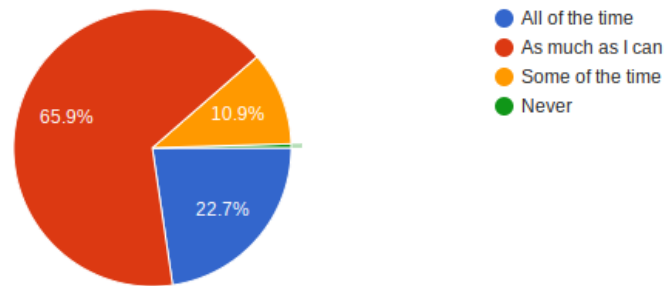
Would you like more water points around school for you to fill your bottle from?

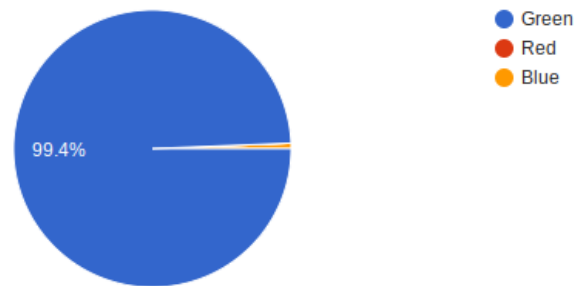
Do you make the effort to separate your rubbish into recycling and general rubbish school?

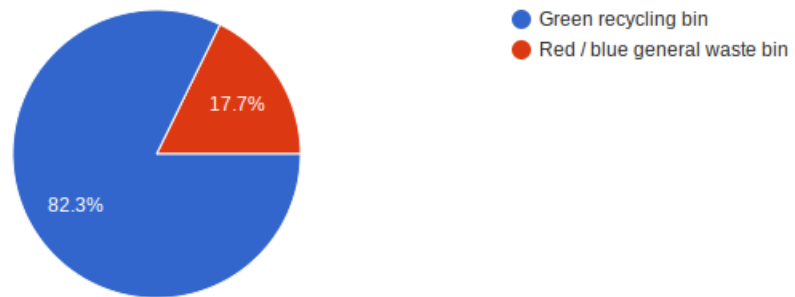
What colour are the recycling bins around the school site?

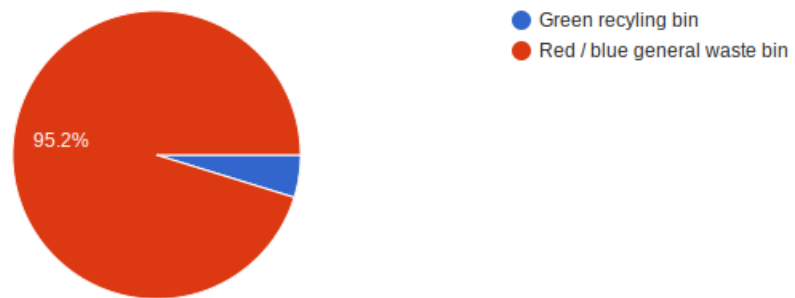
Which bin would you put a plastic bottle into?

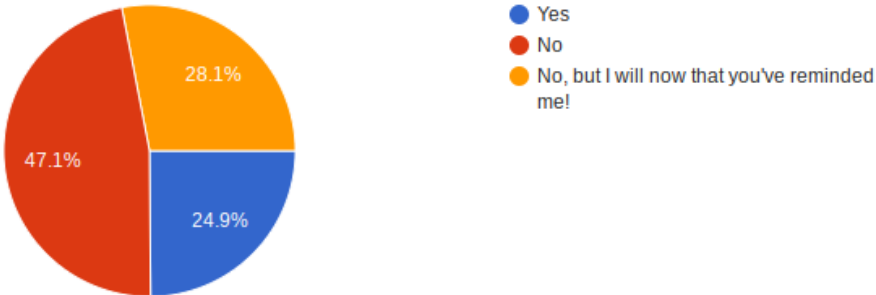
Which bin would you put a piece of clingfilm into?

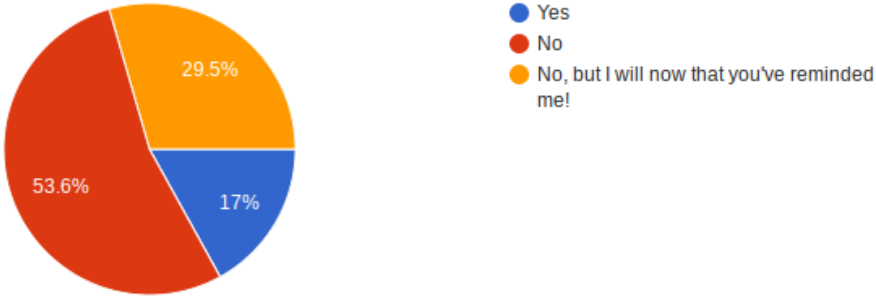
Do you use the crisp packet recycling point outside the main hall?

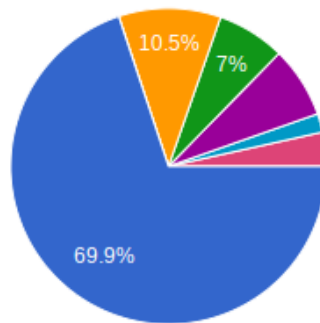
Do you use the pen recycling point outside the main hall?

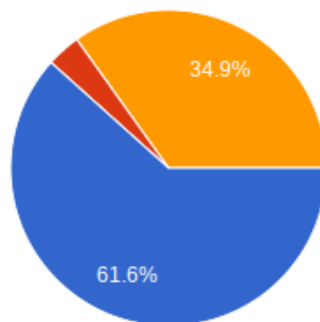


- I make a conscious effort not to drop litter
