Safety

As we manage the return to school for all our pupils I must ask for your continued support to ensure the safety of us all. Whilst the number of covid cases continues to fall, instances are still high. It is very important that we all follow the measures in place to reduce risk. When collecting and dropping off children can I ask that only one adult accompanies a child and that adults do not gather outside. Please wait maintaining a 2 meter distance from other adults. Masks must be worn when dropping off and collecting your child and the one way system must be followed at all times. Thank you.

Devices

If you received a device from school to access remote learning can you please ensure your device is returned on Monday 8th March when school reopens.

Important Information

We have been informed that on some occasions parents and carers are dropping children off outside the gates and children are making their own way through the yard and into school. For the safety of all of the children you must ensure you see your child into school. If you do drop your child off at the gates and do not enter the yard you must not leave the premises until you see your child has safely entered the building. Thank you.
