

Paper Plate Sheep

You will need:

- Paper plate
- Cotton wool balls
- PVA glue
- Paintbrush or glue spreader
- Black card
- Googly eyes
- Scissors
- Pencil
- White coloured pencil



First, use a white coloured pencil to draw a head, four legs and a tail for your sheep onto black card.



Next, use scissors to carefully cut out the different pieces.



Now, flip the plate over so that it is upside down. Then, carefully put a little glue onto the ends of the legs and stick them at the bottom of the plate. Also stick the tail onto one side of the plate. Leave to dry.



Next, flip the plate over again so that it is the right way up. Now spread some glue all over the surface of the plate.

Paper Plate Sheep

You will need:

- Paper plate
- Cotton wool balls
- PVA glue
- Paintbrush or glue spreader
- Black card
- Googly eyes
- Scissors
- Pencil
- White coloured pencil



Begin sticking the cotton wool balls onto the sticky plate! Try to cover the whole plate with cotton wool, then allow to dry.



Now you can decorate your sheep's face. Begin by sticking on two googly eyes. Then use the white coloured pencil to draw on a nose and mouth.



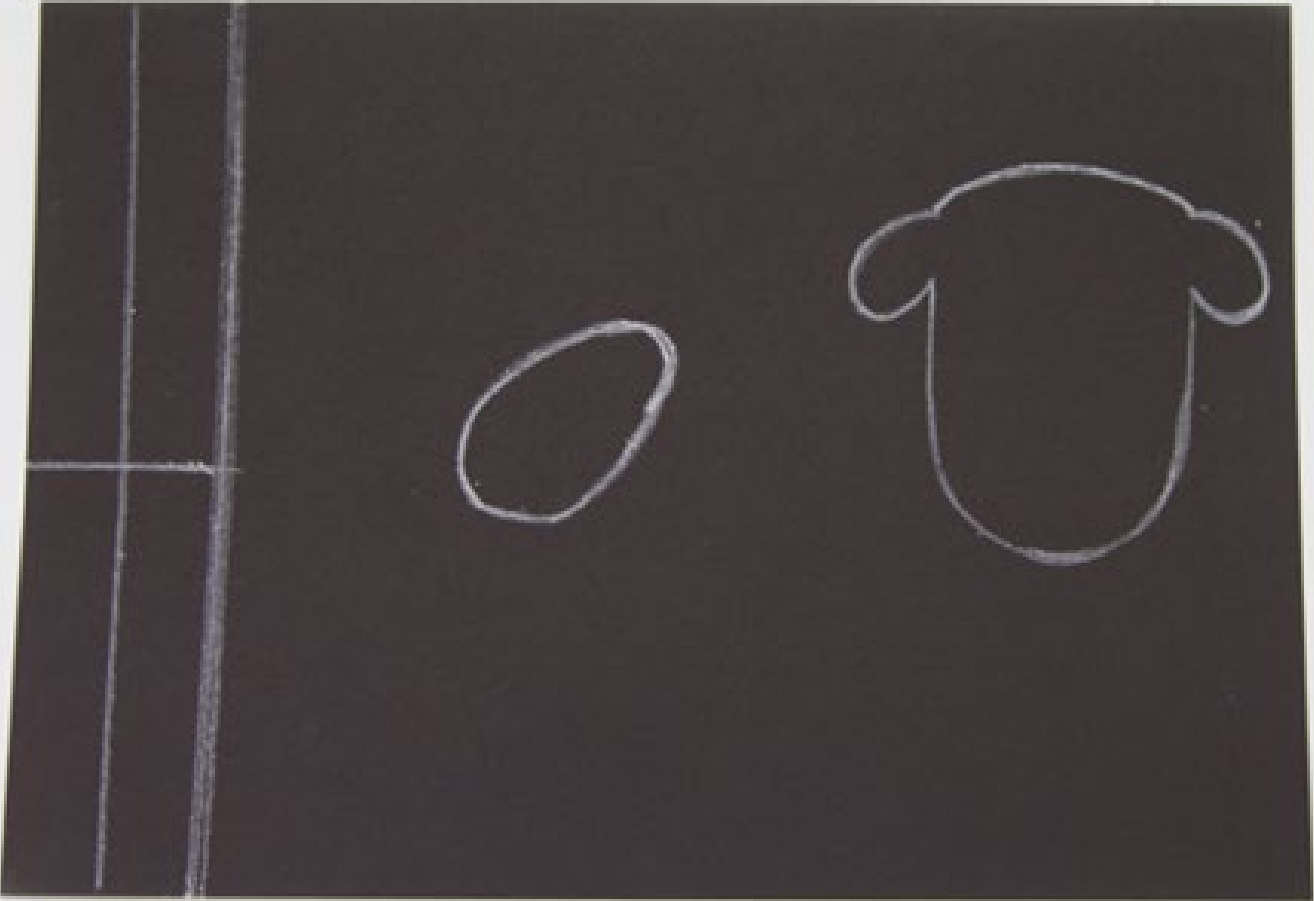
Finally, stick the face onto the cotton wool balls at the opposite end to where the sheep's tail is. Allow to dry and you should have a lovely paper plate sheep!

Paper Plate Sheep

Step 1

First, use a white coloured pencil to draw a head, four legs and a tail for your sheep onto black card.



Step 2

Next, use scissors to carefully cut out the different pieces.



Step 3

Now, flip the plate over so that it is upside down. Then, carefully put a little glue onto the ends of the legs and stick them at the bottom of the plate. Also stick the tail onto one side of the plate. Leave to dry.



Step 4

Next, flip the plate over again so that it is the right way up. Now spread some glue all over the surface of the plate.



Step 5

Begin sticking the cotton wool balls onto the sticky plate! Try to cover the whole plate with cotton wool, then allow to dry.



Step 6

Now you can decorate your sheep's face. Begin by sticking on two googly eyes. Then use the white coloured pencil to draw on a nose and mouth.



Step 7

Finally, stick the face onto the cotton wool balls at the opposite end to where the sheep's tail is. Allow to dry and you should have a lovely paper plate sheep!
