### Dear Parent / Carer

We are looking forward to all pupils rejoining us the week beginning March 8th. I am writing to you with key reminders so that the return to school goes smoothly for all pupils and families. I have attached a leaflet of key information and ask that you can go through this information with your child before they return to school. These are non-negotiable expectations that all pupils must meet on their return to school.

# **Health and Safety Updates**

### **Face Masks**

- All pupils must wear a face mask in all communal areas classrooms, corridors, scholars buses.
- Pupils should also carry a spare mask. Please ensure your child brings two masks to school.
- Teaching staff will wear masks in all communal areas. When teaching, staff will wear masks when they are within 2 metres of any pupil.

### **Attendance**

- All pupils are expected to attend school from the 8th March. The specific dates for year groups were communicated in <a href="mailto:this.letter">this.letter</a>.
- If you have a child in the family who falls into the Clinically Extremely Vulnerable category please contact the relevant Pastoral Leader to discuss how we can support you.
- Siblings of Clinically Extremely Vulnerable children are still expected to attend school.

## **Testing**

- Every pupil will have the opportunity to have three tests in school. This will happen between the 8th and 19th of March.
- It is then expected that testing will continue at home. More advice will be provided on the distribution of home testing kits at a later date.
