- If you have a target grade 6 and above in maths at the end of year 11, you can take the **Higher GCSE Statistics**

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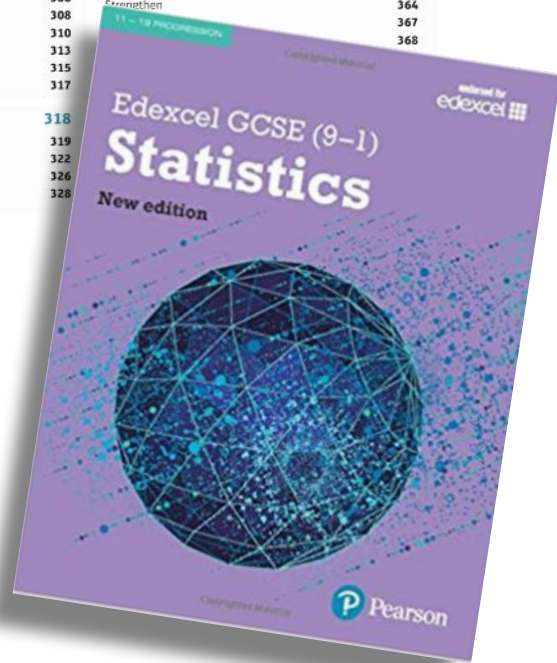
Year 9 Options | Course content

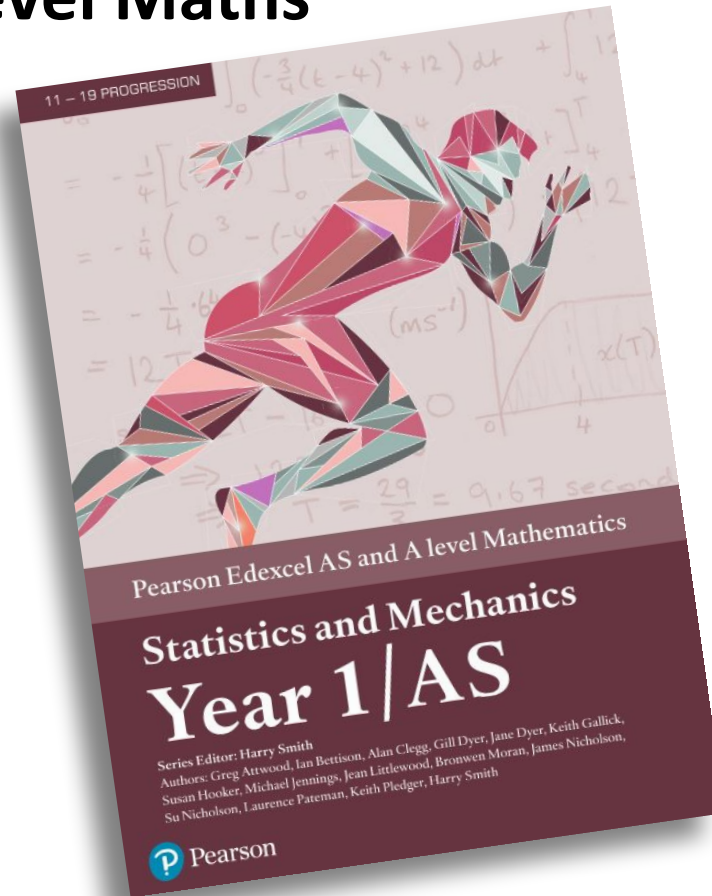
