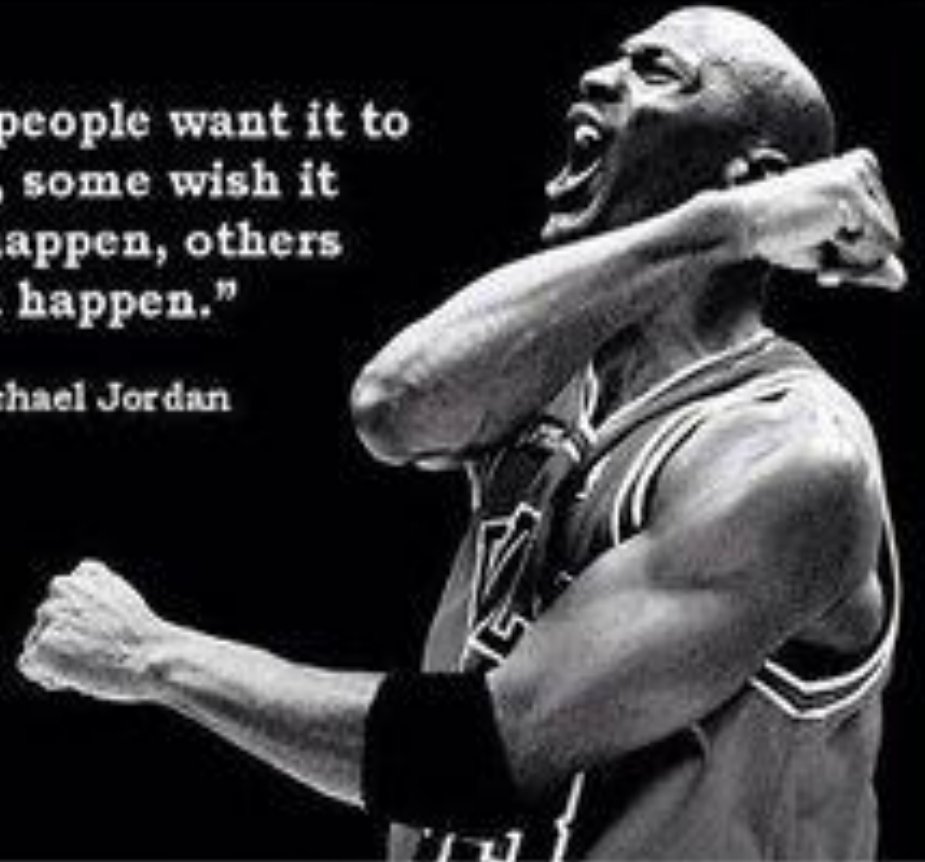

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Role of the Form Tutor

- First point of contact for pupils and parents
- See the students twice a day – morning and afternoon
registers, check equipment, planners, uniform, reminders, Daily Notices and messages
- Discuss any issues and problems with the pupils and parents - especially the first few weeks
- During the year – run a tutorial programme – support studies
- Extremely supportive – experienced team

Communication Student Planner and Gate way App



- Planners are issued in September and students are expected to have this for every lesson.
- In September all parents will be sent a link to download the GATEWAY APP. This will be used to share rewards and sanctions, timetables and attendance tracker.



THE SCHOOL DAY



- Registration: 8:30 – 8:40 in form groups. Form tutor will greet the students each day and make sure they are ready for school.
- 4 lessons before lunch
- 1 lesson after lunch
- Form time 3.05pm to 3.30pm everyday except Tuesday.
- Early finish Friday(3.20pm): Reward for students with a positive week
- Year 7 will always be at Lower School.



ATTENDANCE & PUNCTUALITY

- On his return a note in his planner or a letter must be provided
- For planned absences, a letter seeking permission for the authorisation of the absence must be sent in advance for the attention of Mr Lamb
- Any pupil who, for whatever reason, arrives late to school **must** sign in at the school office on arrival

CATERING PROVISION
