This booklet is designed to provide parents/carers with information about summer holiday activities that are available for children and young people. The information in this booklet is not exhaustive, and inclusion in this booklet does not mean that the Joint Service for Disabled Children endorses the activities.

It is split into three sections:

1. Universal Activities

These are inclusive activities that are accessible to all children and young people. You need to book and pay for these yourself. If are in receipt of a Short Breaks Grant you can use this funding to pay for the activities.

2. Universal Plus Activities

These are activities for children and young people with SEND who need some additional support. You need to book and pay for these activities yourself. If you are in receipt of a Short Breaks Grant you can use this funding to pay for the activities. For those who do not receive a Short Break Grant the Joint Service for Disabled Children has subsidised the cost where shown, for this summer only.

3. Specialist Activities

These activities are for children and young people with SEND, who have complex needs. You may be referred to the activity and it will form part of your package of care. You can however, buy additional days directly from the provider, as can parents/carers who do not receive a care package.


