Role of the Form Tutor



- First point of contact for pupils and parents

- During the year – run a tutorial programme – support studies
- Extremely supportive – experienced team

The School Day



- Registration: 8:30am – 8:40am in form groups. Form tutor will greet the students each day and make sure they are ready for school
- 4 lessons before lunch
- 1 lesson after lunch
- Form time 3.05pm to 3.30pm everyday except Tuesday
- Early finish Friday(3.20pm): Reward for students with a positive week

Student Planner & Gateway App



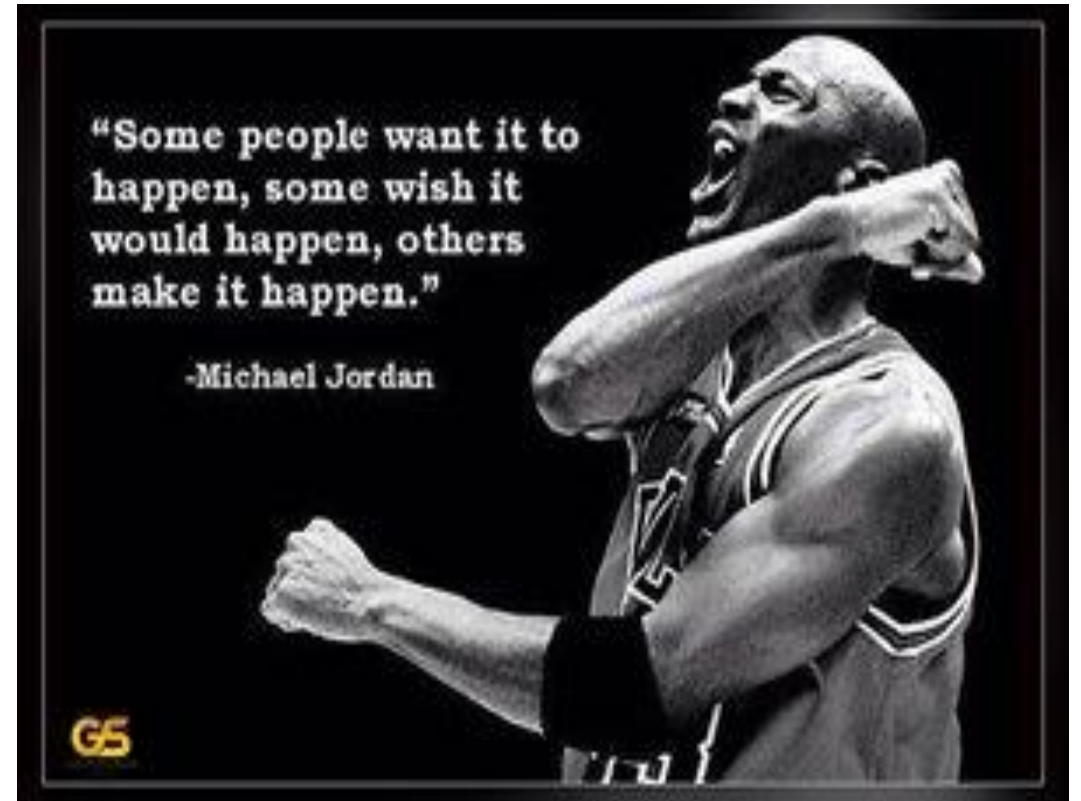
- Planners are issued in September and students are expected to have this for every lesson.
