

Free School Meals/ Pupil Premium Application Form

We want to make sure that we provide your child/children with the best education and support we can. School meals in Enfield are healthy, tasty, social and fun. Research has shown that healthy school meals improve children's learning and productivity.

Families who receive certain benefits may be eligible for free school meals

Apply for free school meals if your child/children attends an Enfield school, and you receive one of the benefits listed below:

- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of **no more than £7,400 (£616.67 per month)**
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit only (**with no Working Tax Credit**) with an annual gross income of no more than £16,190. **Working Tax Credit is a disqualifying benefit regardless of your household income – this means that you would not be entitled to free school meals whilst in receipt of Working Tax Credit**
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)

We check to see if your child qualifies for free school meals using the Department for Education's Eligibility Checking Service (DfE ECS). If your child is entitled to free school meals, we will write to you and the school to let you know when they start. If the result of the check cannot be determined, we will write to you to request proof of benefit.

! Before submitting your application, please note the following:

- **Some schools in Enfield manage their own free school meal process. If your child attends one of the following schools, please contact the school directly:**
AIM North London, ARK John Keats, Brimsdown Primary, Churchfield Primary, Eastfield Primary, Lavender Primary, Oasis Academy Enfield, Oasis Academy Hadley, One Degree Academy, Walker Primary, Wolfson Hillel Primary and Wren Academy Enfield.
- **Applications for free school meals must be made to the Local Authority where the school is located.** If your child attends a school that is NOT in Enfield, please apply to the Local Authority where the school is located.
- **There is no provision to backdate free school meals.** A child is only eligible for free school meals from the date on which their eligibility is checked and confirmed by the Local Authority.

Extra funding for your child's school

Schools can claim additional funding from central government, known as the 'Pupil Premium' for every child whose parent or carer receives one of the benefits listed above. This additional money is used to ensure that children achieve academically and have full access to educational and cultural activities. However, it is for the school to decide how the money is spent. For more information, please ask at your child's school.
