Re: Parent Governor Election

I am writing to inform you that the School has two new vacancies for the role of parent governor within our Governing Body.

It is important to stress that no previous governor (governance) experience is needed – just a desire and passion to support the school and governing body in providing the best education for our boys. The role of a School's Governing Body:

- Ensuring clarity of vision, ethos and strategic leadership
- Accountability for the educational performance of the School and its students
- Overseeing the financial performance of the School

How the Governing Board works and its structure:

- Meetings are usually on Thursday evenings either at Upper School or via Zoom.
- The Full Governing Body meets four times per year and you would be expected to be at each of these meetings.
- There are four sub-committees that focus on finance, learning and teaching, community stakeholders and admissions. Each committee meets termly and, as a governor, you will be expected to be a member of two committees.

As a parent governor, you will work with the board and the senior leadership team in school to ensure it effectively carries out the duties referred to above.
