Introduction	A Level Art, Craft and Design is a continuum from the GCSE Art, Craft and Design. It is essential that students applying for the A Level course have a dedicated interest in Art, a conscientious approach to their studies and a willingness to experiment. Students must achieve a grade 9-5 pass in Art & Design GCSE.	
What is the course about?	The 2-year course is structured to enable students to develop their knowledge and understanding of a wide range of artistic techniques and processes including drawing, painting, printmaking, sculpture and ceramics. Students will gain experience and refine their skills through a series of workshops in the first year towards chosen themes. During the second year, students will produce work towards their Personal Investigation which is based on a theme set by the individual student.  Work produced for this specification will demonstrate the use of formal elements and creative skills, and give visual form to individual thoughts, feelings, observations and ideas. Students will show evidence of extending their own and others' ways of seeing the world. Integrated into the course is the study of other artists, craftspeople and designers to inform and develop	
	ideas towards their intentions.	
How will I be assessed and what will I be studying?		
	Both components of work are internally marked by the Art Department a moderated by a representative from the exam board.  A grade cannot be awarded to a candidate who does not produce work assessment objectives.	•
