












### PLANNING AHEAD



At KS3 your son will have studied over 15 different subjects as part of the school's 'broad and balanced curriculum'. We believe this is key to helping your son develop as a well rounded, successful individual.

We still believe this is important for Key Stage 4, but your son must narrow that range down to 9 GCSEs.

This presentation will guide you through the process and give you advice to make the right choices because choosing the right GCSEs will help to keep the right doors open for your son.

### KEY CHANGES



New grading system 9 to 1 has replaced A\* to G.

Exams are more difficult and rigorous. Changes to grade boundaries.

Terminal, end of course exams ONLY. First entry only.

Controlled Assessment (coursework) reduced.

Marks for SPAG –Spelling, Punctuation & Grammar.

Grades 7, 8, 9 - equivalent to  $A^*/A$ 

Grade 6 - general requirement for A level study (B).

Grade 5 - 'strong pass' (high C)

Grade 4 - 'standard pass' (low C)

# ENGLISH BACCALAUREATE (Ebacc)

Government measure aimed at "...increasing the number of students taking rigorous academic qualifications."

Ebacc = Grade 5 or better in English, Maths, 2 Sciences, History or Geography and a Language

The government believes that these are "...the subjects most valued by universities and employers."

# THE OPTIONS PROCESS - STEP 1



#### Step 1

If your son is to follow the Ebacc route they will have to study GCSE French or GCSE Spanish AND

Either GCSE History or GCSE Geography

(this does not mean they cannot study GCSE Geography & GCSE History)

### THE OPTIONS PROCESS - STEP 1



If your son is **not** going to follow Ebacc route, he will **have** to choose to study:

GCSE Geography

# THE OPTIONS PROCESS - STEP 2



#### Step 2 (Free Choice)

Ebacc Route: Your son now has to choose two other subjects (free choice) and two reserve subjects

Non-Ebacc Route: Your son now has to <u>choose three</u> other subjects (free choice) and two reserve subject


KS3 (Y9) Options KS4 (Y10 & Y11) KS5 (Y12 & Y13) University / FE / Work / Apprenticeship









Click "Accept the green Invitation" button in the email you received from sims.co.uk to register an account. When you have registered your account. Click the Log In button and enter details when vour new prompted. This will take you to the option screen. Double check that your (child's) name appears at the top of the purple screen.

Click directly onto the subject name to add to your selection in both the Compulsory and then the Free Choice sections. To add a reserve click the reserve button next to subject name. Subjects (including reserves) will be shown on the right hand side of the screen.






When all of your choices are made, you can amend your order of preference here by clicking on the number and then the green box underneath the number to vour desired order. do this for main choices and also reserve choices.

Click Save to save your choices and submit the form to us. The form can be amended afterwards.
