Dear Parent/Carer,

We are looking ahead with eager anticipation to the start of the new academic year. We would like to share with you one of our main guiding principles for next year: “**No Lost Learning**”. It is imperative that our students are enabled to make the most of their learning time. To this end, we will continue our focus on punctuality and attendance and will be introducing consistent classroom routines designed to free up students’ cognitive load to focus on learning.

One additional measure we are taking to eliminate lost learning is to insist that all students are fully equipped to learn, every lesson, every day. Our list of essential equipment is set out below, but in order to support parents and students in having the necessary equipment, we are pleased to inform you that ready stocked pencil cases as well as a recommended model of calculator will be available for purchase via Parent Pay from 4 August 2025. Equipment will be checked every morning by form tutors who will expect to see the following in a **clear pencil case** (to enable efficient checking):

- 2 x black pens
- 1 x green pen
- 1 x pencil
- 1 x pencil sharpener
- 1 x rubber
- 1 x highlighter
- 1 x scientific calculator
- 1 x maths geometry set

In order to embed our new routines, we have taken the decision to remove the annual benchmarking day in favour of year group assemblies, followed by House group tutorial sessions. These will take place on **Wednesday 3 September** and your son should attend at the time listed for his year group:
