Campuses

Five campuses across the capital

- We have five campuses across London and 3,500 students. Whilst we are large, we still have a close-knit, community feel at each of our campuses.
- We provide hands-on experience learning outdoors, with over 40 acres of gardens and open landscapes across our campuses, zoos, gardens and farms.
- Our Enfield Campus is where it all began back in 1968. It is our largest campus, not only home to zoo, farm, 30 acres of land, 60 gardens, dog grooming salon, floristry retail outlet, but also home to our higher education provision.
