Re: FREE SMALL GROUP BEGINNER BRASS LESSONS FOR YEAR 7 STUDENTS

We are delighted to announce that the Music Department has secured funding to offer 40 Year 7 students the opportunity to take part in 10 weeks of free, small group beginner brass lessons. This is a fantastic opportunity for our Year 7 students and we are so excited to get this project running to get more brass players in the school and continue to build our wonderful department.

Lessons will be once a week for 30 minutes in groups of 4 students. The time of the lesson will change each week to ensure minimal disruption to learning as this will avoid students missing the same lessons each week. We have been lucky enough to be given 30 brand new trumpets and trombones from Femi and TJ Koleoso; ex-Grammar boys and founding members of the Mercury and BRIT Award winning Ezra Collective. Initially, your son will not be able to take an instrument home but the instruments will be available in the Music Department for him to practice. Following the 10 weeks, students that wish to continue with their instrument, will be offered free hire of an instrument so he can take it home from this point following the signing of an Instrument Hire Agreement.

This very exciting opportunity will be offered on a first come, first serve basis as we only have 40 places available. We need students who will take this seriously and genuinely want to take part in this programme. Students that miss 2 lessons in a row without reason will be removed from the programme and replaced with someone on the waiting list. Students who do not uphold the behaviour expectations we have at Enfield Grammar will also be removed. Please speak with your son about this opportunity to ensure this is something he wants to do, agrees to attend every lesson and demonstrates excellent behaviour throughout.
