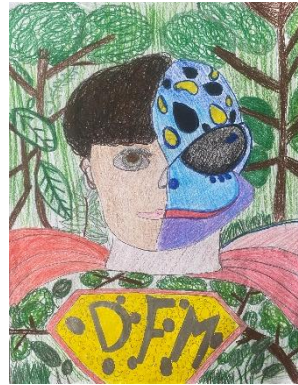


Thank you to our Art Students who helped at the Enfield Grammar School Year 4 and 5 Open Afternoon.

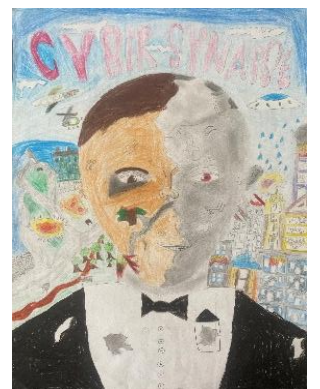
Visitors had the opportunity to create a raised salt painting, where they drew designs using white glue and sprinkled with salt and added water colour paints.

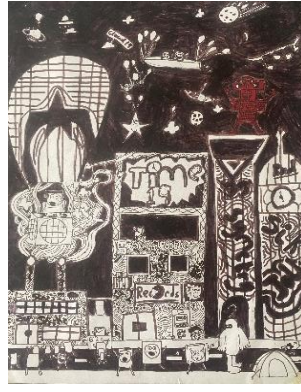
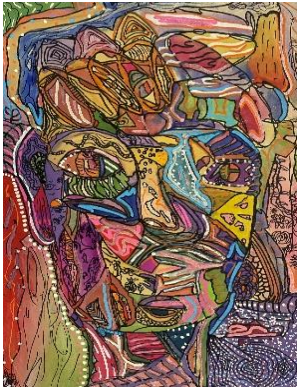

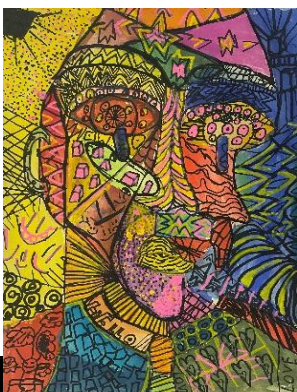
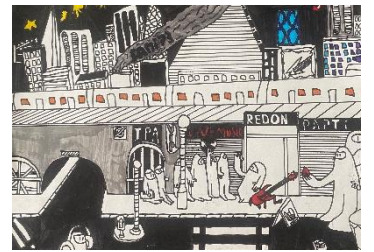
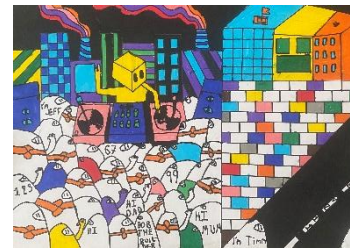
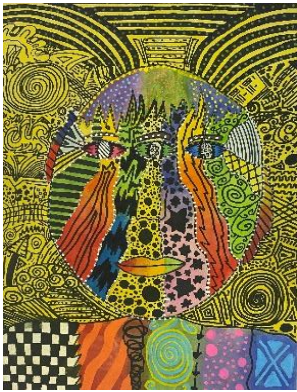


Year 7 students were asked to create a design of a super hero character, based on a portrait of themselves.



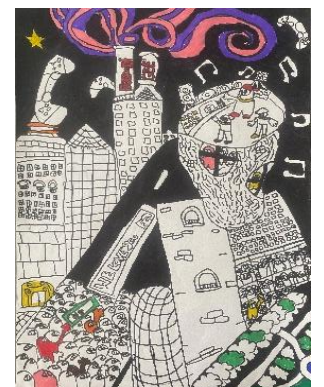

This was a mixed media project using Coloured Pens, Pencils and Watercolour Paints.



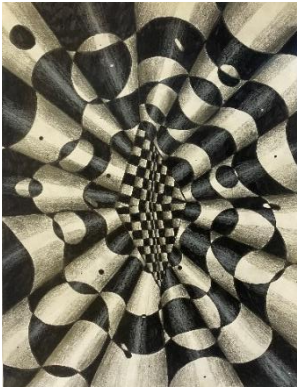

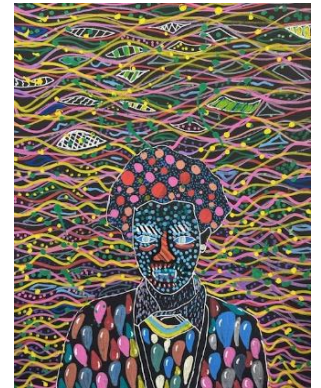
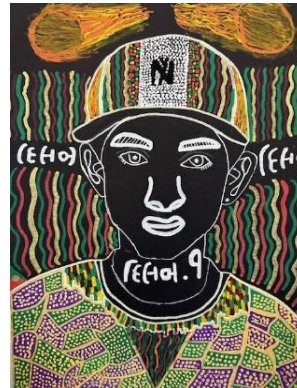
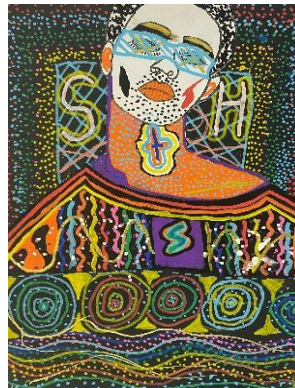
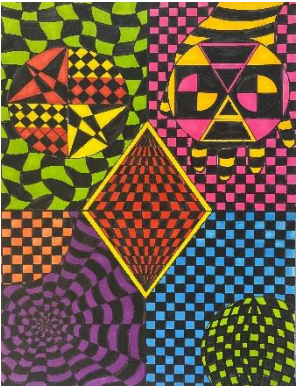
Working with clay, Year 8 students made Totem poles.
