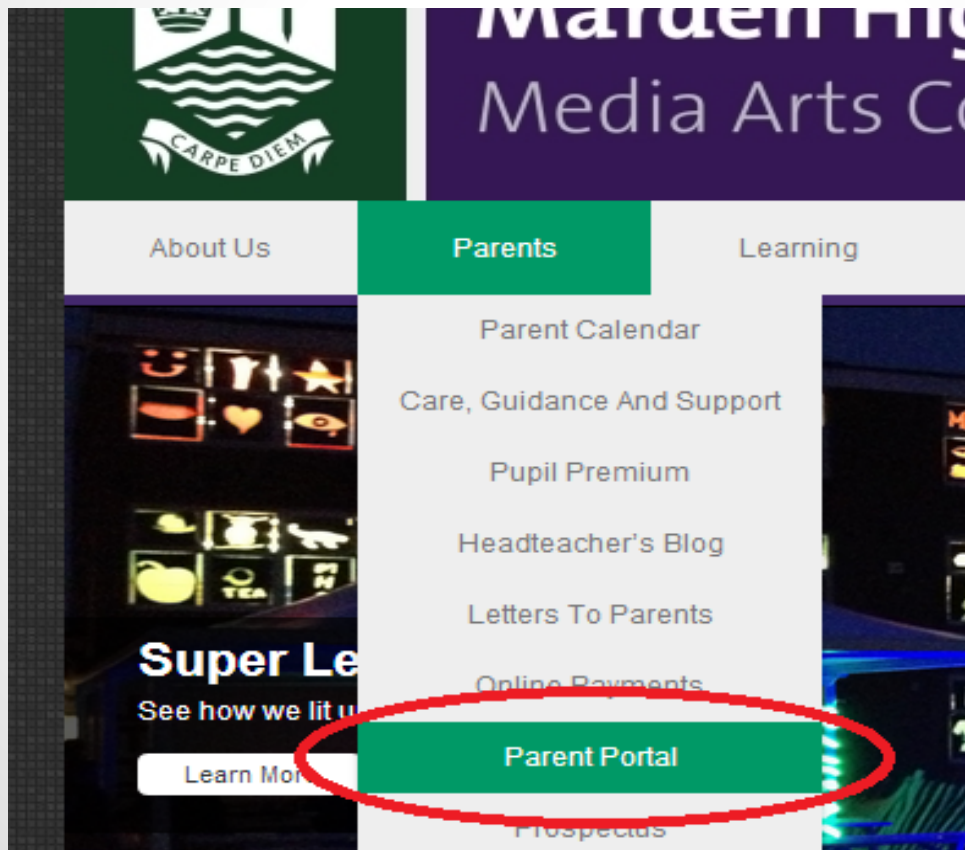

The Role of the Year Coordinator

- To support students to achieve their very best
- Using data to identify underachievement
- Work with students, parents/carers and subject teachers to make sure students are reaching their full potential

Your child's progress at Marden



- Each student has personalised targets
- Target Minimum Grades (TMGs) can be found in the front of each student's handbook and on SIMS parental portal
- Contact with parents via telephone, meetings and emails
- Progress monitored through data collections, case conferences and interim/full reports.
- Interim reports and full reports will be emailed out to parents.

How can I support my Child?



- **Establish an evening routine – set time and place for homework/revision.**
- **Provide a place to work – somewhere quiet they can spread out books, is supplied with items – pens, pencils, post it notes, has access to computer, etc**
- **Help them to plan a revision timetable in advance of exams. Students should do at approx 2 hrs work a night (with breaks). Revision/prep should start now - even if this is only 20 mins at a time**
- **Encourage them to use a variety of revision techniques. Revision websites, such as sam learning, bitesize are useful “top ups” for homework and for revision. There are lots of good revision booklets available to purchase**
- **Support their revision by reviewing what they have done**
- **Provide opportunities for breaks and treats to reward good progress and to maintain motivation**

- Language is a 2 year linear course.
- Students entered for foundation or higher.
- 40% written coursework completed before May year 11.
- 60% exam at the end of year 11 for Language.
- Literature is also a 2 year linear course.
- 25% coursework.
- 75% external exam consisting of 2 papers.
- Sets 1-4 will be entered for Literature.

- Linear 2 year course.
- Sets 1,2 and 3 will have the opportunity to sit the higher paper.
- Set 4 will sit a foundation paper.
- Exams (2 papers) will take place at the end of Year 11.
- No coursework element.

- All students in yr 10, with the exception of BTEC students, will be taking the external exams in unit 1 for biology, chemistry and physics next June 2014. The exams are just after May Half Term.
- The students will also be completing a practical science exam in school during the week of Nov 18th. This practical exam, along with the three written exams, make up the GCSE Core Science.
- For students following the triple science path, they will still have to complete all exams at the end of yr 11. However, by completing the unit 1 exams we will have a clearer idea as to their progress towards top grades in June 2015.
- For those students following the Additional science path the completion of and success in the Core Science exam is very significant as it is the first of two good GCSE science grades that students are expected to leave school with for further and higher education and training.
- Revision books are available to buy. Please use parent pay or bring money to the finance officer.
- Revision sessions will be provided to support all students in preparing for the exams. These will commence in the New Year.
