**Only climbing up stairs counts.**

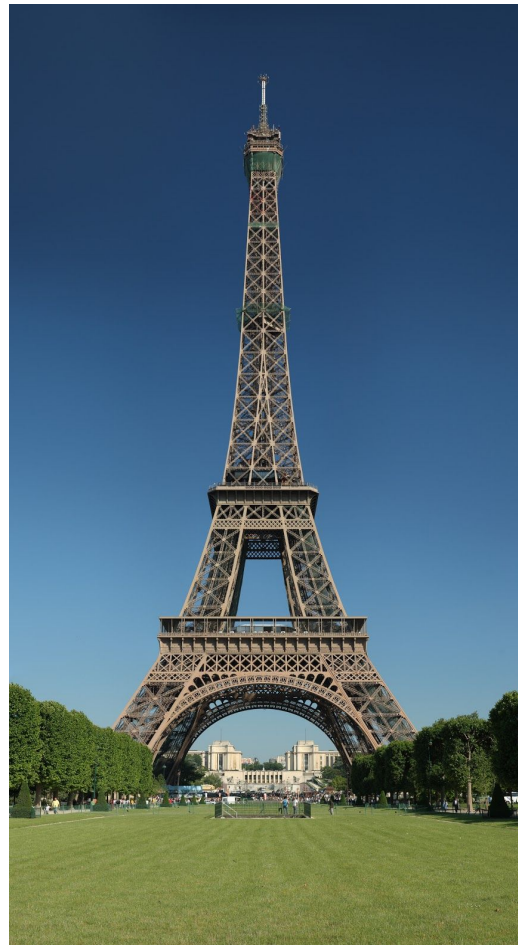
For each challenge completed your name will be added to the list of climbers displayed on the website and given 20 house points.

World's tallest building 1889***



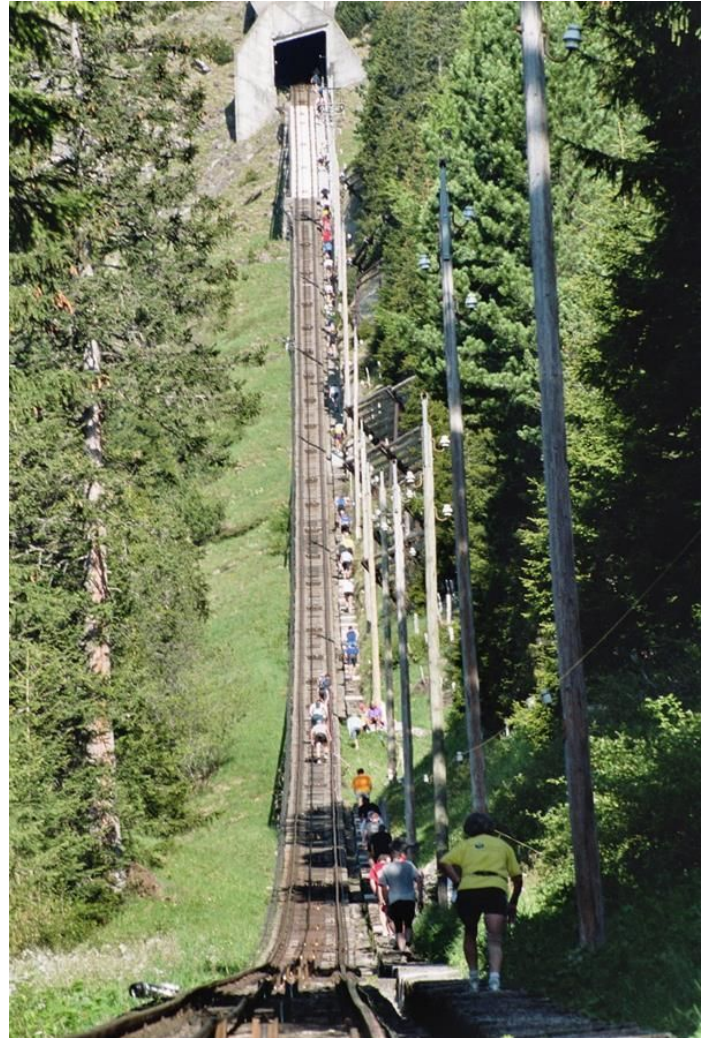
***1,665 steps***

***11,674 steps***

Each one is a separate climb, start again at the bottom once you have finished the last one. Be honest!

E.g. Mrs Mellor, Eiffel Tower, 17/04/20, 4 days.
