## Girls School and PE Uniform



#### Girls' Uniform

Blazer with school badge	To be worn at all times.
School clip on tie**	Worn in the correct manner.
Black V neck jumper with school logo***	Jumper with logo is compulsory. Sweatshirts or hooded sweatshirt tops are not acceptable.
Black dress trousers	Must reach the waist, fashion trousers such as hipsters, combats, jeans, cords are not acceptable.
Black skirt	Knee length, pleated or A-line to allow freedom of movement NO SPLITS. No fashion skirts.
White school shirt	Long enough to tuck into skirt or trousers. Must button up to neck to allow tie to be worn correctly. Pull on tops; polo shirts or zip fastened tops are not acceptable. No fashion blouses.
Black low heeled shoes	Trainers, canvas shoes, fashion shoes, flip flops, mules or sandals are not acceptable. Boots may only be worn in severe winter weather, but must be changed out of on arrival at school.
White socks or grey, black or natural coloured tights	No footless tights or leggings.
Sensible outdoor coat	Hooded sweatshirt tops or similar fashion tops are not acceptable.
Overall for Art	An old shirt would be suitable.

Overall for Art	An old shirt would be suitable.
