## <u>Absence</u>


• A reminder if your children will be absent from school, please telephone the school office or email your child's crew leader.

- your child has a temperature of 39°C or higher



Call 999 or go to A&E if:

• your child is having difficulty breathing – you may notice grunting noises or their tummy sucking under their ribs

- there are pauses when your child breathes
- · your child's skin, tongue or lips are blue
- · your child is floppy and will not wake up or stay awake
