XP Doncaster Colour Run Permission Letter To be completed and handed to Crew Leaders by **Wednesday 16th July 2025**

In order for your child to participate in the XP Doncaster School Colour Run Challenge, you must complete the following prior to the event.

- 1. I am aged 18 years or above and wish for my child to participate in the Colour Run Challenge and I am the parent/legal guardian of the registered child/children who is/are under the age of 18. I wish for these child/children to participate in the Colour Run.
- 2. I agree that my child will participate in the Colour Run Challenge in accordance with the specific safety rules clearly explained by school staff at the beginning of the challenge. This includes the wearing of **plastic sunglasses** provided by the school to act as a layer of protection of the eyes/or bring your own
- 3. I understand that participating in the Colour Run Challenge is a potentially hazardous activity where coloured powder and water will be thrown at and around my child during the event. However, I understand that the powder is not harmful to people, animals or plant life.
- 4. I agree to provide a t-shirt (preferably white) to wear on the course.
- 5. Participants are expected to exhibit appropriate behaviour at all times and must always follow the instructions that are given to them. They must show respect towards the other pupils taking part, school staff, equipment and facilities and not misuse these in any way.
- 6. I confirm that my child is in good physical condition and has no medical impairments that may prevent them from participating in the activity. If I have any concerns about their physical condition, I will inform my child's crew leader straight away.
- 7. I acknowledge that I have read, fully understood and agree with all of the above prior to signing below.
