R1 door



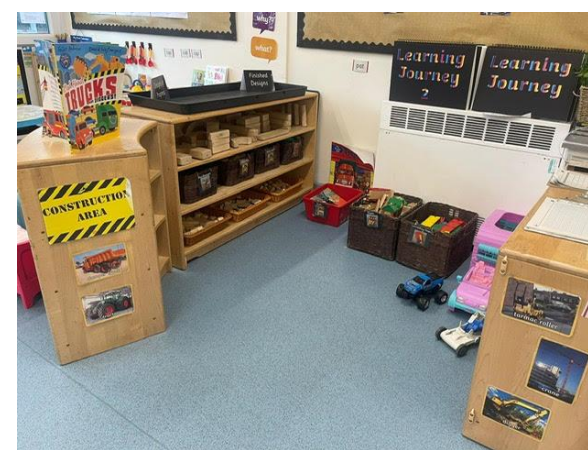
R2 door

When you arrive, you will hang your school bag and coat on your peg, which will be labelled with your name and a special picture.

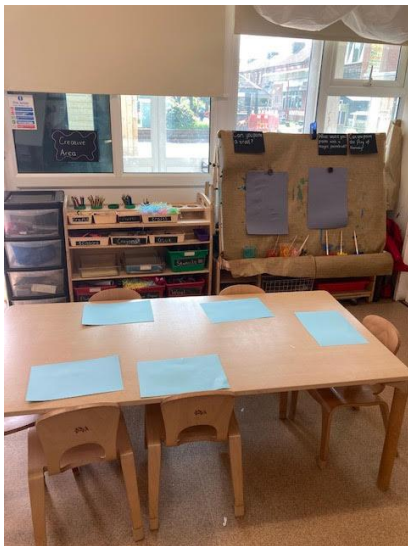


This is the trolley where you will put your lunch box and water bottle.

Preparing your child for Reception!

Read through the 'Starting Reception' booklet with your child so they become familiar with what their new learning environment looks like and who their new teachers are.

Here are some ideas for games and activities which support your child in being ready for learning in Reception.....

Help your child to hold a pencil correctly and practise writing their name. Please see letter formation sheet attached.



Encourage your child to notice and point out numerals when out and about.

Playing games such as 'I spy' using initial sounds in words.
