Female Genital Mutilation (FGM) is when parts of the female genital area are cut or harmed in a way that can cause serious long-term damage. FGM is illegal in the UK and is a form of child abuse. It can have harmful effects for those who experience it.

At All Saints, if we suspect that a child or adult has been affected by FGM, we are required by law to report it to the police to protect them.
