Stage 3

Removal to support classroom

If student does not adjust behaviour:

Removal to **Support Classroom** (yellow slip)

Text sent home to parents & **School lunchtime detention** - issued by office
(C3)

Stage 2

C2—consequence

B code issued for poor behaviour

H code issues for non-completion / poor quality of homework

P / A / E— Planner codes issued

Stage 1

C1—personal reminder of behaviour expectations

C1—personal reminder of organisation expectations (given once per term)

Your teacher will tell you what they expect of you. If you adjust your behaviour now, there will be no further action.
