Who to Contact

The relationship between school and home is a key one one as a successful partnership between us will support your child's learning, progress and happiness at school. Our aim is to work with you and your child to ensure that happens, which is why it's important to talk with us if you have any questions, concerns or wish to share information with us.

Sometimes, especially when you are new to the school, it can be hard to know who to contact. Our reception staff will be able to direct you to the right member of staff but as a general guide, the key routes for contact are as follows:

- > For most pastoral matters, your child's tutor will be the first point of contact;
- > If the matter remains unresolved, or for more complex pastoral matters, please ask for your child's Head of Year;
- For matters relating to lessons and learning in a single lesson, please contact your child's teacher in the first instance;
- > If the matter remains unresolved or is more complex, please ask for the Head of Faculty in that subject area;
- For other matters, please describe your situation to our reception staff and they will direct you to the appropriate member of staff.

Please remember that many of our staff are also teachers which means that they will not be able to make immediate responses due to their teaching commitments. We aim to respond to all queries within 2 working days; for more complex queries this initial contact may be a holding response whilst we look into your concerns. If your concern is more urgent, please explain that when you make contact.

Spanish and French Homework

Homework for Spanish and French will be predominantly set via *Memrise* which is a fantastic website that allows students to learn and consolidate their language learning. The lists that students work from are created by their teachers to match what is being delivered in the classroom but it Is not an Ansford Academy site. This means that students should be aware of any information they share or communicate through the website. Please remind your child not to share personal information and to be aware that any person is able to use the website.

Geography Trip: Year 11

Year 11 Geographers will be carrying out their first field work trip at Lyme Regis. Mr Cue's group will visit on October 6th and Ms Perkins on October 7th, this trip is in preparation for their GCSE exams.

History Trip: Year 9

We are taking 60 year 9 students to a History workshop at the M shed in Bristol next Tuesday to find out more about Bristol's involvement in the slave trade.

From Mrs Wood, Head of PE

Important information

- 1. If your child is in school but unable to participate in PE (for example due to injury), please send them in with a written note in their LogBook. Students will still need their PE kit as they will be asked to participate in PE in a non-performing role (e.g. coach, umpire, helper). Exceptions will be made where the nature of the injury prevents them from getting changed or taking part in this capacity.
- 2. If any students have had any piercings over the summer then please send them in with some tape to put over the earrings for PE lessons. Once students are able to remove piercings, they will be asked to do so for health and safety reasons.

Hockey Fixtures

We have Year 7-11 hockey fixtures booked over the coming two terms. If your child comes to the lunchtime club and is selected to play in the team, you will receive an email containing all the details on the Friday of the week before the fixture. All students playing in hockey fixtures will need shin pads and a gum shield. As the weather gets wetter, football boots are also recommended.

If you are the parent of a student involved in a fixture then you will need to complete the fixtures consent form (link below) to give your consent. This lasts for the five years that your son/daughter is at Ansford. We have moved to this information being online so are asking parents in all years (7-11) to complete this.




