Year 11 Trial Examinations Timetable

As you know, Year 11 students will have a series of trial exams this December, these will be commencing on the 27th November 2023. A timetable is enclosed for your reference and you will also find a copy of it on the Academy website.

This is an excellent opportunity for students to experience what it is like to take a number of exams in a small space of time as they will have to in the summer of 2024. It will also help them to experience what it is like to revise and plan ahead so that they cover all the material needed. The enclosed 'Revision Planning for Students and Parents' provides information to help students prepare for the exams; includes techniques and strategies for effective revision and helps by providing handy checklists and how to formulate a timetable. Teachers will be explaining what students will need to revise for each exam and giving guidance on how to do this on a subject level.
