Camp Tsavo



- It is situated in the south of Kenya about 5 hours drive from Mombassa
- The camp has 10 wooden buildings including
- 3 communal rooms for meeting, for canteen, for relaxing
- There is a 24 h security post at the entrance of the camp

- There are 2 shower and toilets blocks for males and females
- 5 buildings are sleeping accommodations.
- All rooms made of wood and fabric. They host 2-3 beds mosquito nets electricity 2-3 plugs 2 windows

Camp Tsavo

- Camp Tsavo welcomes a few projects
- Mama supports several of group of women some of them windowed
- They received help to learn to write and read.
- They make also jewelry clothing, souvenirs and paper made from elephant poo collected in the hills.
- They also run a small garden and collect water as the region suffered from long term drought
- All items are sold in shops and markets

The projects



- During the month the students will work on the projects such as :
- making jewelry
- designing paper from elephants' feces
- planting tomatoes
- visiting local villages
- learning the wildlife in a sanctuary
- seeing the big fives in their element: lions, leopard, rhinos, elephants, buffalos, as well as giraffes, zebras.....




















Camp Muhaka

- Camp Muhaka is located in the East of Kenya
- The camp has 5 buildings
- 1 building has 6 bedrooms for the staff
- Each bedrooms has 4 beds
- The students stay in 2 dorms each dorm has 8 beds
- There is a self contained building for students and staff any school with less than 20 students
- There is a main room that the students use as a canteen and a meeting point
- 1 building with toilets and showers one side for males one for females
- Each block has 5 showers and toilets

- The camp has several tents each tent host 6 students
- There are 2 toilets and shower blocks
- A swimming pool

The Masai village

- The traditional Masai village is located 1 h from Dani beach and ocean camp
- •The Masai live a secluded life
- They train for war and survival
- They regularly performed sons and traditional dances
- They also make jewelry and survival kits sold to tourists and visitors

The food

- Each camp have a kitchen and staff.
- They are aware of allergies issues
- The students have 3 meals and a snack in the afternoon
- Breakfast 2 choices :
 - Cold 2 choices of cereals and milk
 - Hot: toast eggs beans sausages pancakes
 - Fruits and orange juice tea and coffee
- Main meals lunch dinner:
 - 2 choices : pasta rice potatoes mash banana gary beef chicken fish stew vegetables (spinach beans) tomatoes sauce soup
- Snacks: crisps pancakes biscuits local cakes- fruits
- Each camp has a set of filtered bottle where the student can refill
- The students wash their own plates
