

# Passport, Visas & Travel Insurance

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## Passport

You need one! Your passport must be current and have an expiry date with no less than six months left from the date of your return. You will receive a stamp in your passport on arrival, so make sure there is enough space available. Please ensure you meet these requirements to avoid being refused on the flight by the airline.

It is always good practice to take a photocopy of your passport with you when you travel – just keep it separate from your actual passport! It is also a good idea to leave a copy at home.

**If your current passport needs to be renewed ahead of travel, please action this as early as possible to ensure you have the new passport back in time for when we request the details.**



## Visa

Before you depart for your expedition to Kenya, you'll typically need to apply for a Single Entry visa. It's your responsibility to ensure you have obtained the correct visa, prior to departure.

A Single Entry visa is valid for 3 months from the date of issue until the date of return from your expedition, therefore it is important you only apply for your visa once you're within 2 months of your departure date. If you apply too early, your visa may not be valid for the dates of your expedition. We'll send you an email to remind you nearer the time.

Currently, the price of a Kenya Tourist Visa is \$51US. This is to be paid when applying online. Please visit the embassy's website [here](#) to apply.

It's your responsibility to follow the correct visa requirements based upon the nationality of the passport you will be travelling on. Please check all relevant visa requirements prior to departure.

## Travel Insurance

We take out a travel insurance policy for each volunteer as part of the expedition. This is provided by Millstream and the policy covers all aspects of a Camps International expedition. Please see [click here](#) for a few of our Key Facts Summary.

There are also some points you need to note;

- Whilst on expedition, the policy may cover pre-existing medical conditions as long as it has been declared to Camps International and you are not travelling against medical advice.

- Pre-existing medical conditions that are unstable at point of booking are not covered for cancellation prior to departure.
- Mental health conditions are not covered by our Travel Insurance policy, therefore you will need to arrange additional cover for your specific condition to include cancellation and curtailment cover. It is important to declare your specific condition to the insurer or your policy may not be valid.
- There is no cover for personal effects.
- Policies may be subject to a minimum insurance claim threshold. Please see Key Facts Summary.

It's your responsibility to ensure you have adequate cover for all your health conditions. If for any reason our policy does not cover you, we require that you obtain appropriate travel insurance that does. This will need to be purchased prior to departure. It is your responsibility to provide Camps International with the details of your policy so these can be shared with your expedition Leadership Team in the case of an emergency.
