Mental Health and Suicide Prevention

We would like to signpost families to <https://www.ripplesuicideprevention.com/>, this is an organization set up by the sister of a young man who took his own life. She accessed his online activity and found he had made over 90 suicide related searches in the months before he died.

By downloading R;pple onto home devices, phones etc. all searches that may include possible suicide related materials are blocked and a screen directs you to mental health services.

The charity that set it up estimates that they have saved 31 lives in the short time that they have been operating.

We will now keep a log of borrowed uniform - if borrowed uniform is not returned we will charge the cost of the item from our Second-hand Uniform Shop.


