Dear Parents/Carers,

**RE: Sports Days Mon 14th July & Tues 15th July 2025.**

After a successful Sports day last year we will be continuing with two Sports Days with two different themes. Monday 14th July will follow a traditional theme where athletics is the sport of choice. All students will be involved throughout the day following our interform format. Break and lunch will remain at the same time and students will be able to buy lunch and snacks as normal. Students will need plenty of water and should bring to school a reusable water bottle so that it can be filled up. We will provide water stations during the day. Sunhats and sunscreen if the weather is nice and warm clothing if not.

Tuesday the 15th July will see our second Sports Day, A Celebration of Sport, where all students will complete a carousel of sports activities that students will choose in advance of the day. These activities will include Rounders, Football, Dodgeball, Benchball, Team Building, Table Tennis, Capture the Flag and a 3km run. Students will be able to purchase snacks and lunch as normal. During this day students will compete in their Ansford colours. Students will need to arrive at school in full Ansford PE kit but may choose to wear a t-shirt in their new colour. Again suitable clothing for the day is needed.

After lunch the day will finish with students participating in a colour run. There is a cost to this activity and we are asking for a £3.50 entry fee. This fee includes a pair of sunglasses and covers the cost of the paint. If your child does not wish to take part then there will be a separate activity scheduled for non participants.

Deadline for payment is Monday 30th June and can be made online through The School Gateway payment system.

I hope you agree these are two exciting days for our students and I look forward to them embracing the opportunity to participate and continue to work on their teamwork skills.
