

#### From Mrs Sweetlove, Pastoral Lead- Attendance & Inclusion

As part of our ongoing focus on **attendance and punctuality**, we are placing a strong emphasis this year on supporting students to arrive **on time**, **every day**. Being punctual sets a positive tone for the day and ensures students don't miss vital learning time—just a few minutes late each day quickly adds up to hours of lost education.

#### **Why Punctuality Matters:**

- Students who arrive late often miss the crucial start-of-day routines and instructions
- Being late can cause unnecessary stress and disrupt learning—for both the student and the class
- Consistent punctuality builds good habits for life and shows respect for others.

### **Help Your Child Start the Day Right:**

A good morning routine at home is key. Here are a few helpful tips:

- Set a regular bedtime and wake-up time
- Prepare school bags, uniforms, and lunches the night before
- Aim to arrive at school **10 minutes before the start time**, to allow for a calm start to the day.

#### **New Punctuality Procedures:**

To ensure consistency and fairness, we are introducing the following steps:

- If a student is **late 3 times to the legal registration periods (Am reg & Period 4) in one week** without contact from a parent or valid medical evidence, a 1-hour after-school detention will be issued.
- If a student is late 5 times in a two-week period, a 2-hour after-school detention will be issued.
- For **persistent lateness**, students will be placed on **tutor reports** and may require additional support and monitoring.

We understand that occasional lateness can happen. If there is a genuine reason for your child being late, please contact the school office or provide medical evidence where appropriate.



#### Attendance and Appointments – A Reminder to All Families

As we move through the academic year, I want to take a moment to thank you for your continued support in promoting good attendance — something that plays a vital role in every child's education and long-term success.

This year, I've noticed a significant increase in the number of students already being taken out of school for appointments during the school day. While I completely understand that some appointments are unavoidable, I'd like to kindly remind all families to book appointments **outside of school hours wherever possible**, to minimise disruption to your child's learning.

When appointments during the school day cannot be avoided:

- Please ensure your child is out of school for the shortest time possible
- I encourage students to come into school before their appointment or return afterwards, wherever this can be managed
- All students must be signed out at reception by a parent or carer listed on the student's contact list, or by someone the school has been informed about in advance through written or verbal authorisation
- Students are not allowed to leave the premises alone unless prior arrangements have been made with the school.

It is also essential that you notify the school in advance of any appointments and provide evidence (such as a letter, appointment card, text or email confirmation). In line with Department for Education (DfE) guidance, schools cannot routinely authorise absence for appointments without supporting documentation. If evidence is not supplied, the absence will be recorded as unauthorised.

Please also be aware that in accordance with DfE guidance, if a student accumulates 10 sessions (equivalent to 5 full school days) of unauthorised absence within a 12-week period, this may lead to a formal referral and the potential for a penalty notice being issued, this is something we strongly want to avoid.

I understand that balancing school, family life, and appointments isn't always easy, and I truly appreciate your cooperation. By working together, we can ensure that every child is supported to attend regularly and make the most of their learning.

- Bouncy castles permitted


