As Year 10 students are progressing with their study of GCSE English Literature, we would like to offer you the opportunity to purchase copies of the set texts that your child will study: *A Christmas Carol* by Charles Dickens, *An Inspector Calls* by J.B. Priestley and *Macbeth* by William Shakespeare. We are able to purchase at discounted prices so buying through the school should reduce the cost.

While we can provide some copies in school for students to use in lessons, it is essential that students have their own copies that they can re-read and annotate at home. This really is the most effective form of revision for English Literature.

The editions we recommend are as follows:

- Macbeth by William Shakespeare: £5.43
 Oxford School Shakespeare edition, ISBN 978-0-19-832400-3
- A Christmas Carol by Charles Dickens: £2.67
 Wordsworth Classics edition, ISBN 978-1-84022-756-7
- An Inspector Calls by J.B.Priestley: £7.99
 Heinemann edition, ISBN 978-0-435232-82-5

Students also study 'Power and Conflict' poetry and will be given an anthology from AQA.

Other editions of the books are available to buy. However, we find it is helpful for all students to have the same edition of each text as this makes it easy for them to follow in class, locate extracts and identify quotations.

- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
