Year 11 Mock Examinations (November) Timetable

As you know, Year 11 students will have a series of mock exams this November, these will be commencing on the 10th November 2025. A timetable is enclosed for your reference, and you will also find a copy of it on the Academy website.

This is an excellent opportunity for students to experience what it is like to take a number of exams in a small space of time as they will have to in the summer of 2026. It will also help them to experience what it is like to revise and plan ahead so that they cover all the material needed.

Our Year 11 Revision Hub is now live on our website providing information to help students prepare for the exams; includes techniques and strategies for effective revision and helps by providing handy checklists and how to formulate a timetable. Teachers have been preparing the students for these exams and explaining what they need to revise for each exam and giving guidance on how to do this on a subject level.

Shortly, students will also be provided with our 'Student Guide to Examinations at Ansford Academy' (students were provided with a version of this in Year 10). It ensures students are fully briefed on the examination and assessment process in place and that they are made aware of the required Joint Council for Qualifications (JCQ)/awarding body rules and regulations that they must abide by in the examinations process. As well as providing important information, it helps with some of the more practical aspects of taking non-examination assessments and examinations.
