Message from the Head of School Mr Musson

So, our first term of the new academic year comes to an end and it's only 9 weeks until Christmas! (so, my daughter told me!). As ever these last two weeks have been jam packed with amazing learning opportunities for our students. Last Tuesday we held our annual 'Year 2 Sports Festival'. Students from our local primary schools came to take part and I was so impressed with our Year 9 sports leaders who led the activities. It was so lovely to see our students embracing this responsibility and demonstrating strong leadership skills when working with the year 2's, all done with kindness and encouragement. It was delightful to see.

Last Wednesday we ran the first of two Geography Fieldwork trips to Lyme Regis and this year there was no rain - always a bonus! The day consisted of students collecting information to use towards the Fieldwork study they have to complete for the GCSE.

This week we held an all-day rehearsal of Oliver! I am so excited about the show, the vocals coming from the hall were an absolute joy - we are all going to be in for a real treat in December. Whole school productions contribute significantly towards the feel of a school. Having students from across all year groups working together to produce a final performance is truly magical and I cannot thank the staff involved enough to make this happen for our students.

Today I'm fortunate to help assist with the Drama trip to see a performance of 'Blood Brothers'. This is a piece of theatre that students study for their GCSE Drama. I haven't seen this production before so I'm very much looking forward to it.

Students have been sitting their end of term assessments, and our teachers are now starting to provide feedback on how students can improve. These regular assessments are a vital part of ensuring staff and students are clear about what needs to be done to further improve, address any misconceptions and for students to demonstrate that they understand any errors.

I wish you all a lovely half term break, hopefully we'll have some sunshine so we can enjoy the outdoors and see the beautiful autumnal colours.

We have been made aware of a nationwide issue with WhatsApp and a group called 'Add Everyone' which does exactly as it says, adds all contacts in the phone if the message is opened and then sends out inappropriate messages that look like they have come from the sender. Please be vigilant with your children and report online to 101 if this happens. It can be prevented by not opening any messages from 'Add Everyone' and deleting them immediately.

The emphasis is on Ansford as a community and we look out for each other, we have lots of ways for students to report concerns they have about themselves or others - either in person, online or anonymously through the Student Voice Box.

We take seriously our shared responsibilities of working together as a community, striving for excellence in all we do, and ensuring that our school community is valued for who we are and who we can become. Through high academic






Wonderful French Homework from Year 7
