Year 11 Student Guide to Assessment and Examinations at Ansford Academy

Enclosed is our 'Student Guide to Assessment and Examinations at Ansford Academy', an updated version to the one students received in Year 10. This version contains the latest Joint Council for Qualifications (JCQ) rules and regulations, and information for candidates effective from September 2025, which will apply when they take their examinations in summer 2026.

It ensures they are fully briefed on the examination and assessment process in place and that they are reminded of the required JCQ/awarding body rules and regulations that they must abide by. As well as providing important information, it helps with some of the more practical aspects of taking non-examination assessments, coursework and examinations.

Candidate Statements of Entry are issued to students in February. This shows what examinations they have been entered for, along with the tier, if appropriate.

Examination timetables are issued to students before the Easter holidays; these provide students with their personal examination timetable; the times and dates of all of their examinations.

It is important that time is taken to read through the enclosed guidance booklet, paying particular attention to the JCQ candidate information including the Warning to Candidates, Privacy Notice, Social Media and Artificial Intelligence (AI) information.
