Year 11 Mock Examinations (March) Timetable

The March series of mock exams for Year 11 will be commencing on Monday 2nd March and will run until Tuesday 17th March.

A timetable is enclosed for your reference, and you will also find a copy of it on the Academy website.

A reminder that our Year 11 Revision Hub is live on our website providing information to help students prepare for the exams; includes techniques and strategies for effective revision and helps by providing handy checklists and how to formulate a timetable. Teachers have been preparing the students for these exams and explaining what they need to revise for each exam and giving guidance on how to do this on a subject level.
