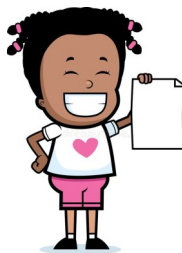


High Expectations

High Expectations, Teamwork, Supportive Challenge, Scholarship, Curiosity and Tenacity

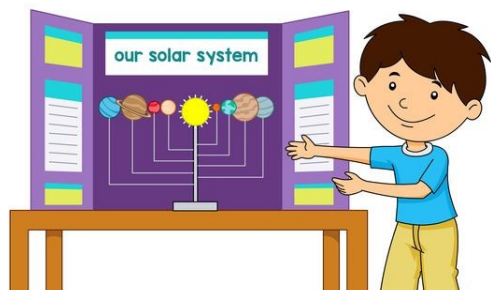
We encourage our children to show these values at home, as well as in school, and use them to extend their learning.
