Due to the ongoing impact of COVID, there is no statutory requirement of schools to publish results and outcomes from the 2021/22 academic year.

"The government will not publish KS2 school level data for the 2021 to 2022 academic year. They have archived data from the 2018 to 2019 academic year because they recognise that the data from that year may no longer reflect current performance."

However, we have decided to publish the statutory outcomes in the chart below. School remains broadly in line with national figures for attainment outcomes in Key Stage 2. The national figures (provisional, September 2022) are also included for comparison.
