Students' research culminates in a 10-hour examination, across two days, in which they make a final piece (outcome). Students' preparation can be referred to during the examination but no additional work can be added once this has started.</p> <p>Both the Candidate Portfolio and Externally Set Assignment are marked using the same criteria across 4 assessment objectives: A01, A02, A03 and A04. The numerical values for assessment 1 and 2 differ due to their weight towards the GCSE qualification.</p>
